

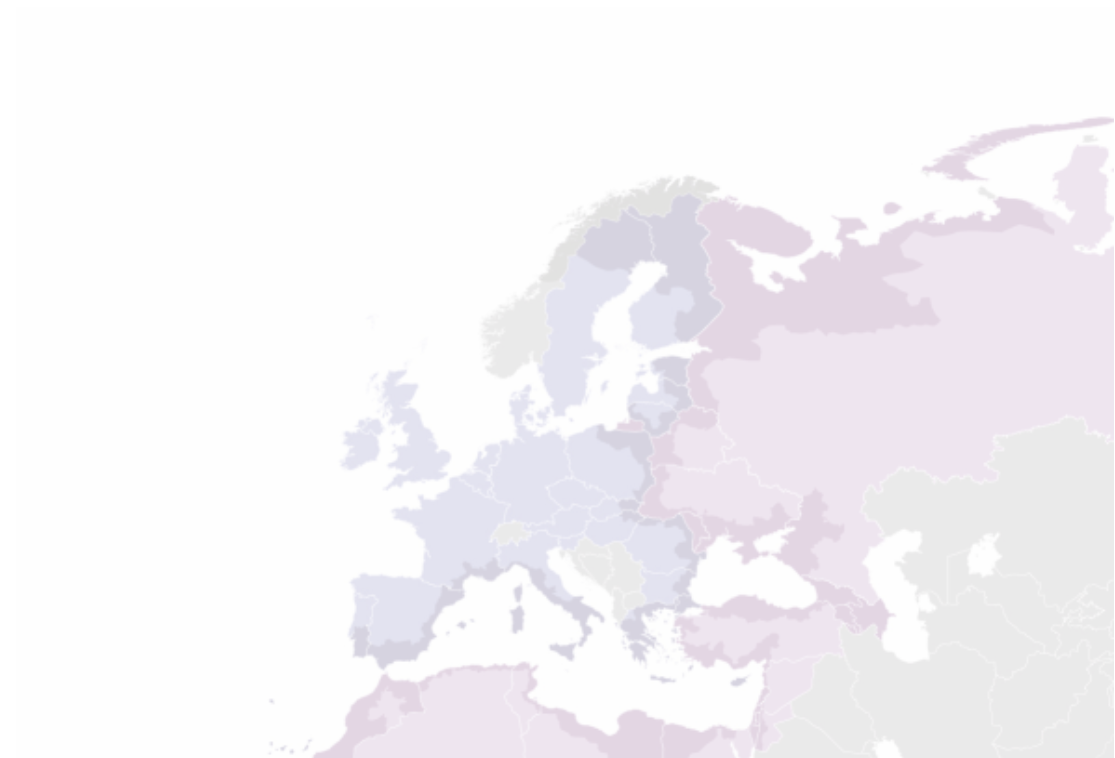

CBC supports sustainable development along the EU's external borders, helps reducing differences in living standards and addressing common challenges across these borders.

CBC specific objectives

- ❖ *promoting economic and social development in border areas*
- ❖ *addressing common challenges (environment, public health, safety and security)*
- ❖ *putting in place better conditions for persons, goods and capital mobility*

❑ Commitment and ownership of Participating countries

Balanced partnership: The project Lead Partner may be from any of the participating countries.

Project ownership: actions shall be jointly developed by the partnership across the borders

Programme Management structures jointly selected by all countries participating in the programme;

Why a ENI CBC programme?



- ❖ *Providing common solutions to common challenges (whether in the field of health, research and education, transport or sustainable energy) through CBC projects;*
- ❖ *Enhancing mutual understanding across the borders through CBC projects;*
- ❖ *Opening greater opportunities for people in the border regions through CBC projects*

Why a CBC project ?

- ❖ Common challenge to be jointly tackled
- ❖ Solutions to be jointly identified
- ❖ Real and balanced partnership
- ❖ Joint implementation

Solutions are jointly developed going beyond the results independently achievable in the involved regions/areas.

The problems identified can be solved more efficiently jointly, instead of individual regions or countries acting alone.

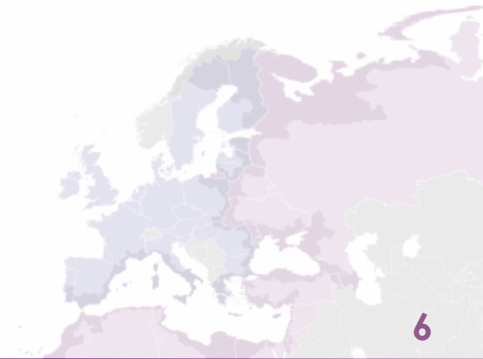
The cross border working approach should be reflected in the project outputs.

All partners have to actively participate in the project according to their functions and competences.

Results of projects jointly designed for mutual benefit on both sides of the border are sustainable only through joint actions.

A new Technical Assistance project, i.e. "**Technical support to the implementation and management of ENI CBC programmes (TESIM)**", has been set up by the EC in 2015.

The objective of this project is to give support to the CBC programmes on both programme and project level **focusing on improving the capacity of Partner Countries to participate in the programmes.**
